Reporting

Page 1 of the run report has Base site and Unit in the upper left. Please be sure these fields have the correct base and unit. Base is the town the squad is from, unit is the squad number. If someone from PCOPS is picking up your squad for a call they will put base as PCOPS and the unit will be the squad number.

Please reread your history and present illness and scene descriptions to make sure the spelling is correct and it makes sense. Remember these are legal documents that are read by doctors and some may go to lawyers.

When given a run number from dispatch, repeat the run number to dispatch to make sure you heard them correctly and document the correct run number on the run report and signature page.

Any call for an injury needs add'l injury detail completed on page 2, within this box you must complete NEMESIS3. All MVA's will need add'l injury detail and motor vehicle incident completed for State of Ohio reporting.

FIN SHEETS

Every patient transport should be receiving a FIN sheet from the hospital you are transporting to.

Staple this FIN sheet to your signature page.

Run Report Corrections.

You will receive a message from Nancy and/or Denise when a run report needs attention. Please take care of the corrections within 24 hours of receiving our message. This includes signing your report. We can not bill insurance until the run report is complete.
